# Graduating 8th Graders or Non-Returning Students

If you own your own iPad, we will remove our MDM and filter software and return your iPad restored to factory settings by Thursday, June 6.

If you have been leasing an LVAES-owned iPad, you may buy out the remainder of your lease (\$460 minus any lease payments you have made). Once your final invoice is paid, we will remove our MDM and filter software and restore the iPad to factory settings.

## **Returning Students**

## BYOD iPads

Because it takes so much work to enroll iPads into our MDM and filter, we would like to leave our MDM and filter in place. However, at a parent's request, we can remove restrictions and open up usage as much as parents would like. This essentially gives you free usage of the device but still gives parents the ability to use the ScreenGuide tools, and it also makes for a smooth transition back to regulated school usage in the fall.

## Leased iPads

Students who have completed the re-enrollment process for next year are able to keep their iPads over the summer free of charge. We will leave our MDM and filter in place, but we can open up usage as much as parents request, including installing apps, allowing YouTube, etc.

# What Should I Expect Next Year if I've Completed the Lease Term?

After you buy the device for \$10, it becomes a BYOD iPad. You will be charged the technology fee on your first invoice but will have no further payments. All other requirements remain the same regarding the MDM, filter, and school expectations.
